Phonelines Liaison:

- **Ainslie** - The Multi-Area Phonenumber Committee is desperate for volunteers willing to respond to Twelve Step calls.
As a Twelve Step call volunteer you could be the first face someone meets in Narcotics Anonymous. Volunteers need 2 years clean time and to have completed orientation.
In this role you would be notified if a suffering addict in your area is looking to get to a meeting, volunteers respond in pairs and meet newcomers at the next possible meeting. This could be someone's first meeting and you would be the first hand showing them the meaning of NA recovery and the strength of our community.
Not everyone will make it through those doors without a guiding hand. Without people willing to assist them many addicts stay out of the rooms out of fear of those doors.

WE ARE PUTTING OUT A CALL FOR SERVICE. Our hope is that two members from each homegroup step forward to complete orientation and be placed on a Twelve Step call list. Our

committee hopes to build a list of members willing to do this form of service, and from there together we can show up for the still suffering addicts seeking recovery. As it currently stands newcomers are reaching out for help and there is no one to answer the call.
